Patrick Wolff, Program Coordinator with the Oakland Zoo (OZ) presented a slide show at October's Lunch & Learn. Henry Snow, a local renaissance man founded Oakland Zoo in 1922. He was recognized as an African big game hunter, film producer, and museum advocate. OZ was established in downtown Oakland at 19th & Harrison (now Snow Park) and later moved to then Joaquin Miller Park (now Knowland Park). Lots of changes to the zoo through the years, especially in recent decades under Dr. Joel Parrot's leadership. General trends in zoos go from private wealthy collectors, to animals in depauperate cages, to larger cages with painted backdrops, to more naturalistic habitats with lots of space. OZ managed by Conservation Society of California (CSC) is viewed as a leader/trendsetter in animal welfare and management in the industry with emphasis more on conservation and education.


